Leatherhead, 1st June 2022 – Hyundai Motor UK has announced pricing for the i30 N Drive-N Limited Edition, an exclusive, special version of the high-performance Hyundai i30 N hatchback. A total of 800 vehicles will be produced, with 75 vehicles destined for the UK.¹
